Thursday September 19 & Friday September 20 - Depart USA & Arrive in Rome.

Depart the USA and arrive in **Rome** where, time permitting, you will take a panoramic tour of this beautiful city. Board the brand new **Celebrity Reflection**.



Saturday September 21 - Sicily, Italy

Explore Messina, a city rich in history, and the “connecting point” with the Italian Boot.

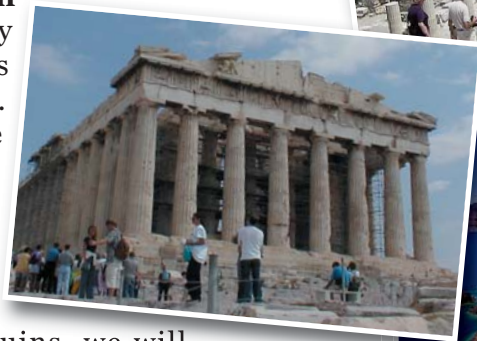
Travel to the mountainside village of

Taormina. Climb to the top of the mountain to the **Greek Theater** with its spectacular view of the Mediterranean beyond. Then pass through the quaint village here, where stars have stayed and artists have lived. Enjoy a gelato while shopping or simply wander the streets with the occasional breathtaking view over the cliffs to the seaside below.

Sunday September 22 - At Sea

Monday September 23 - Corinth & Athens, Greece

Travel to **Corinth** (Acts 18: 1-18), a city that inspired Paul's most familiar letters. You will visit the **Archaeological Museum**, the **Market Place** where Paul's workshop may have been located. Among the ruins, we will stand at the **Bema** where Paul defended the gospel. The architectural splendors of the ancient city of **Athens** remain stunningly beautiful. Follow your guide on a journey to the ancient **Acropolis** where you will see the **Propylaea**, the **Parthenon** and the **Erectheum**. View **Mars Hill** where Paul preached the gospel to the intellectual Athenian community of his day (Acts 17: 15-34). You will also view the **Olympic Stadium**, where the modern Olympics began. (Lunch on own.)



Tuesday September 24 - Ephesus, Turkey Enjoy a visit to **Ephesus**, where Paul had a three-year ministry, and where John the Beloved and Jesus'

mother are believed to be buried. With a population of more than 250,000, Ephesus was the second-largest city in the world. View the **Library of Celsus**, originally built in 125 A.D. that once held nearly 12,000 scrolls. Visit the **temples of Hadrian and Domitian**, and the **great theater** where Paul witnessed.



Wednesday September 25 - Rhodes, Greece

Paul visited **Rhodes** briefly on his way to Jerusalem at the end of his 3rd missionary journey (Acts 21:1). Centuries later, the crusaders known as the Knights of St. John fled Jerusalem and settled on the Island of Rhodes. You will see the castles and the old city they built, which still impress visitors. Over 4,000 years ago, the Minoans were among the greatest civilizations in Europe. (Lunch on ship.)

Thursday September 26 - Santorini, Greece

Visit **Santorini**, the spectacular circular archipelago formed by a volcanic explosion that destroyed this center of Minoan civilization 3,600 years ago. Some sources identify this as the lost city of Atlantis. (On your own; excursion not offered.)

Friday September 27 Mykonos, Greece

Arrive at the world-famous Greek Island of **Mykonos**, where gleaming whitewashed buildings seem to climb atop each other to reach the azure sky. (On your own; excursion not offered.)

Saturday September 28 - At Sea

Sunday September 29 - Naples & Pompeii, Italy In the early morning, your ship will dock in **Naples**, a dazzling city perched on a beautiful rock coast. Paul landed in the **Bay of Naples** on his way to Rome. Journey inland to ancient **Pompeii**, dating almost to the time of Paul, where you will visit the spectacular ruins that were covered by the eruption of **Mt. Vesuvius** in 79 A.D.

Monday September 30 - Ancient Rome

History is woven through the streets and neighborhoods of **Rome** as in no other city. Today you'll explore the many wonders of ancient Rome when you visit the magnificent **Colosseum**, **Mamertine Prison** (where both Paul and Peter were imprisoned), and the **Pantheon**. From the most sacred hill of ancient Rome, **Campidoglio**, you'll view the **Forum**. You'll also view the **Circus Maximus**, the **Arch of Titus**, the famous **Baths of Caracalla** and the **Arch of Constantine**. You'll see the **Victor Emanuel Monument** and the **Monti Region**, Rome's most ancient neighborhood which spreads over three of her seven hills. You'll explore the romance of Rome as you climb the graceful **Spanish Steps** and stop at the famous **Trevi Fountain**. Legend says those who toss a coin into the fountain will one day return to Rome to toss another into the waters of Trevi.

Tuesday October 1 - The Vatican

Christianity came late in her long history, conquering and changing Rome in a way no other movements or invaders were able to do. Today, you will experience the glory of ancient Catholicism when you visit **the Vatican**, home to one of the greatest museums in the world. And, of course, you'll enter **St. Peter's Basilica** and the **Sistine Chapel**, where you'll view **Michelangelo's frescoes** which have been restored to their full, colorful glory.
