

DAY 1 Fly to Tel Aviv.


- **DAY 2** Arrive in Israel. Travel to Caesarea for dinner and overnight.
- DAY 3 Tour Caesarea by the Sea (Paul's port of departure for Rome) & Roman Aqueduct. Visit Mt. Carmel (where Elijah confronted the prophets of Baal), Megiddo & Valley of Armageddon. View Nazareth (Jesus' boyhood home) & Cana (where Jesus turned water to wine). Overnight in Tiberias.
- DAY 4 Visit Caesarea Philippi (where Peter declared, "You are the Christ!"). See the ancient remains of Tel Dan and the altar built by King Jeroboam I. Visit Mt. of Beatitudes (traditional site of Sermon on the Mount). Enjoy Fish Lunch (included in tour price) & Sea of Galilee boat ride. Visit Capernaum (headquarters of Jesus' Galilean ministry).
- DAY 5 See ancient "Jesus Boat," enjoy Baptism in Jordan River. Travel through Jordan Valley with a view of Jericho, & travel Jericho Road up to Jerusalem. Visit Mt. of Olives for a special view of Holy City. Check into hotel for overnight in Jerusalem.
- DAY 6 Tour Shrine of the Book (museum housing Dead Sea Scrolls) & see Model City (to learn of Jerusalem during Jesus' time). Visit Bethlehem, including Church of the Nativity & ancient Shepherd's Cave. Tour Mt. of Olives, including Palm Sunday Road to Garden of Gethsemane (site of Jesus' agony & His arrest).
- DAY 7 Travel to Masada (ancient fortress of Herod), view Ein Gedi (the beautiful "Streams in the Desert" hideout of David) & visit Qumran (site of discovery of Dead Sea Scrolls & ruins of ancient Essene community). Float and swim in Dead Sea. Tour Jericho (world's oldest city).
- DAY 8 Tour Temple Mount & Old City of Jerusalem, including Antonio's Fortress, Pool of Bethesda (where Jesus healed the lame man), & Via Dolorosa. Visit Mt. Zion & tour House of Caiaphas.
- DAY 9 Pray at Wailing Wall next to Temple Mount, & tour Rabbi's Tunnel. Visit on-going excavation at Pool of Siloam. Sense the agony of Jesus' crucifixion at Gordon's Calvary & reality of the resurrection at Garden Tomb with a special communion service.









